## Completion Report of: Joint Sasnaka Sansada and SUMAGA Manusath (humanitarian Relief) Project

We are pleased to inform you that the Sasnaka Sansada Foundation (SSF) has completed the "Manusath" joint project, marking a significant milestone in our joint endeavours.

In late May 2024, Sri Lanka experienced a flash flood due to heavy rain and strong winds from the south-west monsoon. This adverse weather led to widespread floods, landslides, and other weather-related incidents, resulting in numerous casualties and extensive damage. According to the National Disaster Relief Service Centre (NDRRSC), at the end of June 2024, there were 48 fatalities in the districts of Ratnapura, Galle, Kgalle, and Kalutara, with over 100 people injured. Additionally, almost 5,000 individuals were evacuated to 98 evacuation centres, and more than 200,000 people have been affected across the aforementioned districts and the country.

As a responsible, youth-led social service organization, Sasnaka Sansada was very responsive and stepped in to support the families with maximum effort. In this context, the SUMAGA Foundation of Norway wholeheartedly joined hands to extend support. In addition, SSF could also solicit some support from other well wishes.

In this context, we are pleased to inform you that food, dry rations, medicine, and stationery worth LKR 864,000/—were distributed among 220 families and 82 schoolchildren in the districts of Gampaha, Kalutara, Galle, Ratnapura, and Kegalle.
